Patronal Day - St David's Day

A Patronal Festival is the celebration of the Patron Saint of a church. For ours it is St David and it falls on 1 March and we celebrate it on the nearest Sunday. On this Patronal Festival it is good to refresh our knowledge about the patron saint of our parish. St David of Wales was a sixth century monk and later archbishop of Wales. St David was actually called Dewi but when his name was latinised it became Davus and eventually David. He was reputed to be an exemplar of the ascetic, spiritual life but was also highly regarded for his kindness and compassion to others, particularly the poor and sick. He is also remembered for his simplicity of life in his monasticism, his poetry, and his preaching against the Pelagian heresy.

It is believed that he died on 1st March in the year 601.

In the Old Testament reading about Jonah we saw that people of Nineveh whole heartedly accepted God's word through Jonah. They did not wait for any sign but they understood where they stand. That helped them to turn away from their evil ways. Our Patronal Festival always falls during Lent. So this Lent with our Patronal Festival at the door are we able to follow at least some of what St David modelled?
