Reflection on Advent Four


There are thousands of churches and at least three religious orders named after the famous meeting between the mother of Jesus and the mother of John the Baptist ... The Visitation. Many things drew them together – kinship, fear of their circumstances and perhaps a kind of mutual embarrassment at their 'condition' as the Victorian used to say so coyly.

All this as well as understanding and mutual love.

Their meeting is a type of discernment. Mary and Elizabeth are united and drawn to one another, not simply by affection, but by what *grows* in them. In this fantastic time, it is the unborn babes who recognise each other, and this recognition communicates itself to those who nurture and carry them. So they are guided by something they cannot fully understand. In a way, the old woman and the young woman are led on and bonded by their vision of a future they cannot control.

The wisdom of this so easily eludes a society that is too busy to notice things moving within its own womb. But let us, who bear the name of the Incarnate One, be on the lookout for such priceless things.
