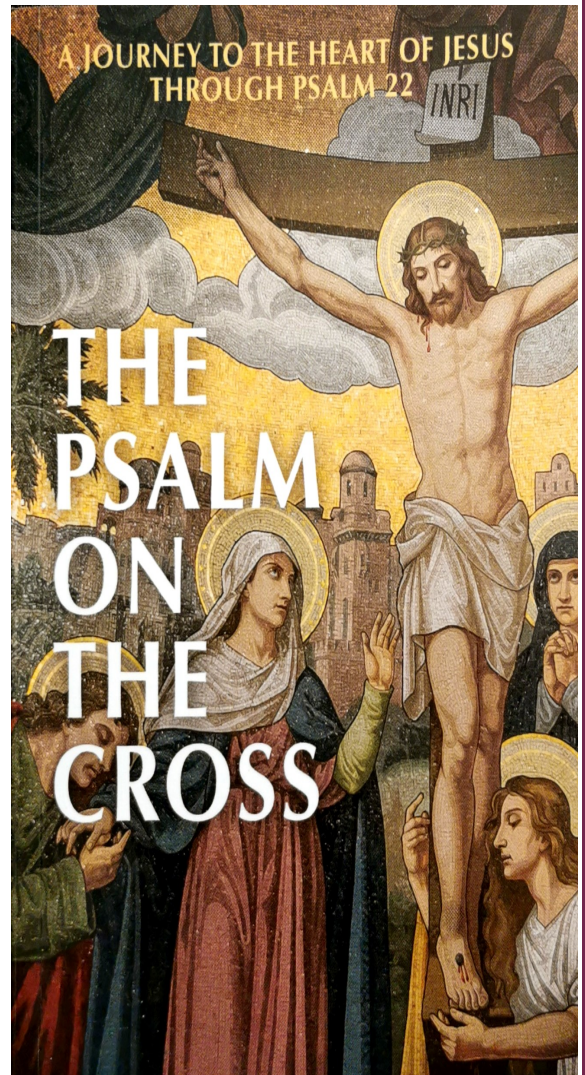
A Journey to the Heart of Jesus Through Psalm 22
